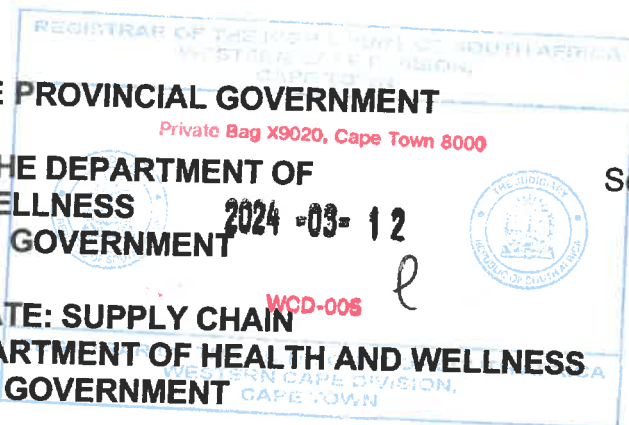

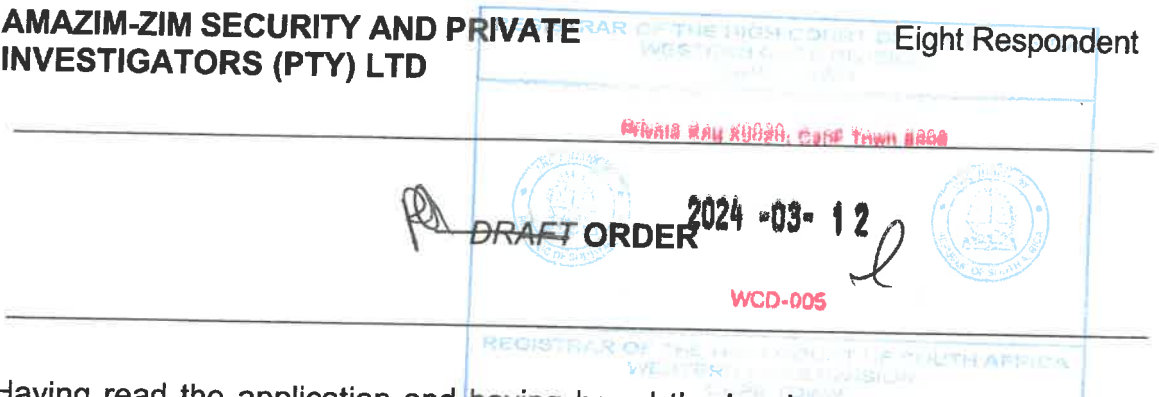

Having read the application and having heard the legal representatives for the applicants and the second to fourth respondents, respectively, it is ordered that:

1. The time period cast in section 5 of the Promotion of Administrative Justice Act 3 of 2000 (PAJA) for provision of full and written reasons is reduced in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 2 below.
2. The first respondent, alternatively the second respondent, is directed to provide the applicants by no later than **Friday 15 March 2024**, with full and written reasons for its decision to discard the applicants' bids for tender WCGHSC 0362/1/2023 ("the decision"), which reasons must deal with the procedure followed and the substance of the decisions taken.
3. The first to fourth respondents are ordered to pay the applicants' costs on the scale as between attorney and client.
